

### 25 May 2000

The Association of All Indonesia City Governments established in 2000 according to Law No. 22 of 1999 concerning Regional Government and Presidential Decree No. 49 of 2000 concerning the Establishment of the Regional Autonomy Advisory Council (DPOD) The Mayor's Working Committee was formed to consider and make recommendations regarding the formation of an "Association of Cities" and was given a name *Asosiasi Pemerintah Kota Seluruh Indonesia* (APEKSI) or Association of Indonesia Municipalities


